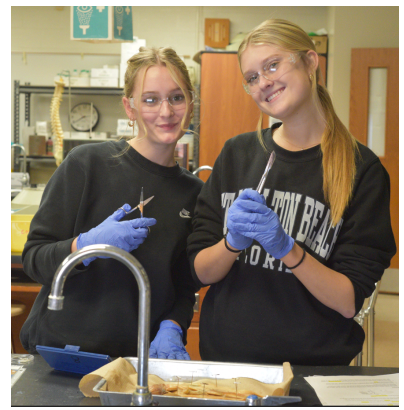


What are your plans after high school? “I plan to attend a 4-year University to major in Civil Engineering.”
